Ann Arbor Summer Festival Cancels Indoor, Ticketed Shows

ANN ARBOR MI (March 30, 2020) – After closely monitoring the spread of COVID-19 and consulting with their partners, the Ann Arbor Summer Festival has canceled this summer's indoor, ticketed events including:

- Black Violin (co-presented with The Ark), June 18 | Power Center
- Scott Silven's Wonders at Dusk, June 21-26 | Zingerman's Greyline
- Kristin Chenoweth, June 24 | Hill Auditorium
- Pink Martini, June 25 | Power Center
- Indigo Girls (co-presented with The Ark), June 30 I Power Center
- The Capitol Steps, July 4 | Power Center

Festival Executive Director Mike Michelon shares,

"While we are disappointed that we can't share this special season with you, we take the safety of our community very seriously. The production process and significant financial investment required doesn't allow us to delay a decision further. Our hope is to reschedule many of these artists for future seasons.

Top of the Park, our free outdoor series, is an important part of our civic life and the next one may be more important than ever. We are committed to delivering a festival of some kind, within the parameters of what's safe, as soon as possible.

As we continue to work with all our partners we will share updates with you as we have them. One thing is certain – when we get beyond this crisis, our community will need to come together, and the Festival will be there to make this happen. The Ann Arbor Summer Festival is an exhilarating celebration of performing arts, outdoor entertainment, and community spirit.
